#### Mission standard Status EUMETSAT





- Currently 8 flying altimeters, with a quite homogenous processing baseline (thanks to coordination between agencies) and with an overall very good data quality.
- 28 years of past data (since Topex-ERS1) to continue improving data quality.
- Sentinel-6-MF/J-CS to come within few days. Using GDR-F standard
- SWOT nadir will use the same baseline and product format
- All splinters summary requiring reprocessing of past data and more frequent updates.
- Thus a busy period with different project constraints (staff and funding)


















### SARAL GDR-F<sup>(-)</sup>





- SARAL has switch to operational GDR-F<sup>(-)</sup> in January 2020
- Saral GDR-F reprocessing campaign is on-going and nearly finished:
  - Years 2014 to 2018 are already released on AVISO
  - Years 2013, 2019, 2020 to come before end of the year
- Standard (-) not fully inline with S6 (naming nomenclature, some aux data, no adaptive retracking) but very close.
- About 70 evolutions have been included in this version, including orbit POE-F








### Jason-1/2/3 Mission Product Status





- Jason-3: GDR-D since 2016
  - Operational switch in GDR-F standard next week (29 Oct 2020) before S6/JCS launch as recommended by OSTST 2019
  - Reprocessing campaign starts Nov 2020 and shall end Apr 2021
  - See (Bignalet-Cazalet et al., Ostst 2020) for details : harmonization with S6 standard
- Jason-2: GDR-D since March 2013
  - GDR-F Reprocessing campaign starts after Jason-3 and shall end Dec 2021
- Jason-1 : GDR-E since April 2016
  - with some caveats on the dry tropo correction when approaching the coast
  - GDR-F Reprocessing campaign after Jason-2 (if funded, potential funding by Copernicus like J3 & S6 for climate objective)

Jason-1

- GDR-F products have been generated using
  - ground retracking (Desjonqueres, 2019),
  - ITRF14 orbit solutions (GSFC and CNES),
  - GDR-F geophysical models (CNES).
- Ongoing cal/val being performed by JPL (See Talpe et al., Ostst 2020 for details) and CNES
- Expected release early 2021
- Poseidon 1
  - GDR-F products in progress using
    - ground retracking >1995 (Thibaut, 2017),
    - SMLE3 < 1995 (when Waveforms not available)</li>
    - ITRF14 orbit solutions (GSFC and CNES),
    - GDR-F geophysical models (CNES)
  - Expected release early 2021








### **GDR-F** groups



• GDR-F standard has **no backward compatibility** with GDR-D, due to variables renaming and the use of NetCDF groups.











### 2020 priorities From N. Picot OSTST 2019





- Jason-3 GDR-F update is the highest priority and has to be implemented in operations before Jason-CS launch. Jason-3 product format and variables names will be aligned to JCS one's
  - -> OK
- Saral complete reprocessing of the mission by mid next year
- -> more than half mission already released; complete mission within next weeks

- Topex GDR-F to be completed in 2020
  - -> shall be OK early 2021
- It would be important to update Jason-1 to GDR-F standard.
- -> Possible after Jason-2 (if founded)
- Tools to convert from new to current product format shall be made available to all.
- -> Double standard production during 2 months after operational switch for Jason-3







#### 2021 priorities



- After Jason-3 GDR-F operational switch next week, the reprocessing campaign is the highest priority
- Fulfill Topex/Poseidon GDR-F release
- Jason-2 GDR-F reprocessing campaign shall be engaged just after Jason-3 one, and finished end 2021
- If possible, prepare Jason-1 reprocessing to GDR-F standard
- Follow Sentinel-6 E1 phase and anticipate futur needs for GDR-G...
